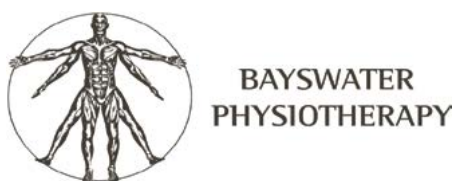
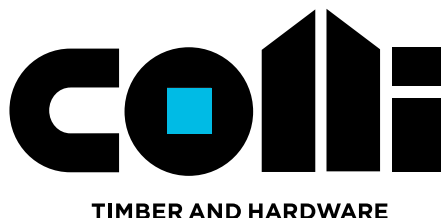

2023 JUNIOR REPORTS

The Baysie Juniors had a very successful year this year both on and off the pitch.

The year started with Non NPL junior numbers increasing from approximately 210 in 2022 season to approximately 290 this season. With the assistance of a number of coaches, we implemented a very successful Trials and Grading system for our Juniors. This attracted many new comers to Bayswater City Soccer Club and also ensured that players were appropriately positioned into teams so that it would maximise involvement and fun for the participants.

The Junior Technical Director, Ricardo Fonseca also started a new coaching system to guide new coaches on the principals of coaching and suggested training programs. This proved to be very successful in building confidence and in aligning the training programs to the needs of the Club as a whole. We have a number of coaches stepping up to start their C Class licence in the coming months. This will provide more depth and skills knowledge to our juniors.

On the pitch, the teams were amazing with all of them being very competitive and hardly losing any games. This shows that our early grading and trial system worked very effectively. I do not believe that we should judge our club solely on the number of games we win or the number of trophies we collect, but on the Club ethos that the players and members carry along with the community spirit that we provide for our juniors. All teams showed an outstanding level of spirit and enthusiasm whilst playing with all their heart for Bayswater City Soccer Club.

Another notable event was where the Bayswater Under 12s blue side travelled to Canberra in July to compete in the Kanga Cup. The Kanga Cup is the largest junior football tournament in the Southern hemisphere consisting of 295 teams ranging from under 9s to 18s. Lead by Baysie boy Ric Fonseca and assisted by Michael Ruggerio, the lads were absolutely outstanding and made it all the way to Final to unfortunately go down narrowly 3-2.

As the season came to a close, there were some further discussions regarding amalgamation with the Infant Jesus Soccer Club. These proved successful and I am pleased to announce that we are now one Club. This will assist with training ground space at Emberson Reserve.

A couple of special points and thanks to note
