FROM THE UNDER 20S COACH

At the end of the 2024 season, we reflect on a campaign that saw Baywater City U 20s secure a commendable third-place finish in the NPL 20s league. This achievement not only highlights our competitive spirit and ability but also sets a solid foundation for the group going into 2025

SEASON OVERVIEW: As this was my first-year coaching, we were keen to hit the ground running with preseason commencing on the 21st of November. From the outset we were keen to get our ideas across to the group in what we expected in and out of possession, we tried various systems and ideas based on what we felt suited best the attributes of the players in which some successful some not but all with the intent of creating a team that played good football and were organized out of possession. To me the team showcased all these attributes throughout most of the season. As the weeks went by, I feel our tactical approach evolved, allowing us to adapt to various challenges throughout the season. Key players stepped up, and our depth was tested through the season with injuries to key players but the resilience of the group in the 2nd half of the season was a credit to all where we went on a 10-game unbeaten run

KEY HIGHLIGHTS: Strong Start: The season kicked off with a series of impressive performances, including a standout victory against Perth Glory and Red Star in Rounds 5 & 6. These games set the tone for our season ahead as both were rivals for the top 4 but also gave the group belief that they could beat anyone when they are switched on and stick to the game plan.

I feel our home ground at Frank Drago, became a fortress throughout the year as we failed to win all but 2 of our home games and the group always felt we could beat everyone at home. We boasted one of the best home records in the league, with memorable victories against Perth SC and Perth Glory being big highlights.

As for any 20s coach a huge part of the role is development and assisting players improve their knowledge and skills of the game whilst also trying to educate the guys on the discipline required to become a first team player at this football club. Several players emerged as key contributors throughout the season and I feel improved hugely from our first session together with Sadaat Mohammadi, Phil Radeski , Sarsan Ahmed , Milan Bulatovic all showing great consistency week in week out.

His dedication to myself and the group should be commended. I am sure he has a big coaching career ahead of him.
